San Antonio, Texas N.A.T.A. Inc. National Convention

On Friday, the 7th day of June at 4:30 p.m., Mr. Jerry Rhea, District Director called the meeting to order. After welcoming everyone he began with an update from the board meeting on points of interest to district. These items follow:

- Dr. James Andrews - President's Challenge cup award will be awarded to him at the banquet Monday night. Since he is from District IX, we should all be proud.
- Olympics or International Games opportunities. To be considered one needs to go to Colorado Springs and volunteer for 2 weeks. Then they may call you or they may not. There is a lot of hard feelings over this and the people who worked the Olympics last year.
- Change of classification - A certified athletic trainer can go back to school and be classified in a subclass under the student category. This will be called Student-Graduate-Certified and National dues will be \$25. Non-Certified members will be Student-Graduate-Not certified and pay \$25. This allows students on limited finances to be able to afford dues to continue as members. Members in these categories need to submit to the National office a letter from their registrar's office verifying full-time graduate status.
