I'm sure by now most of you have heard the *monumental* news in regards to the President signing into law our Sports Medicine Licensure Clarity Act on October 5, 2018. The law will still have to go through the technical rule making process and then publish a draft rule for any comments for 30 days. Again, this legislation allows covered sports medicine professionals to engage in the treatment of injured athletes across state lines, as long as they have an agreement in place with the team or athlete being treated and are performing services within the scope of practice of their state of licensure.

Our SEATA Elections recently ended and I want to thank the membership for their participation. Congratulations to Jeff Hopp re-elected as our Vice President and Donna Wesley who was re-elected as our Secretary. I also want to thank the membership for allowing me the honor to serve a second term as your District Director and look forward to continue working with both the NATA & SEATA Boards on your behalf!




